She moved to St. Louis in the 1930s and was employed in the shoe making trade, being part of the working world well into her 70s. "She's a character," said grand-daughter Debbie Meyer.

So what's her secret to her longevity? A love for beer, even if it is inexpensive, according to Meyer. "My mother-in-law is a very frugal person," said Janice Hamm, Lucy's daughter-in-law. These days, she is more apt to say an "apple a day" helps.

Christina Ahlheim and Megan Meyer, Lucy's great-granddaughters were also in awe. "It's great. I am excited for her. I think she has another decade in her easily! She's still sharp as a tack," Ahlheim said.
